Medication Management Program



The objective of the Medication Management Program is to promote the optimal health and well-being of clients through assessment of medication management needs, drug education, implementation of individualized plans of care, and supervised compliance of clients. Clients will remain in their home environment, achieve optimal health and functioning, and remain compliant with proper medication regimens as prescribed by the client's physician.

• **Initial Home Visit:**

- Initial Assessment by Registered Professional Nurse includes physical assessment and home safety assessment.
- Medication review - Use of computerized Drug Therapy Screening System, which gives printout of use, actions, side effects, food and drug interactions of all medications. This program is provided with a quarterly update by the manufacturer to keep the database accurate and timely.
- Interface with client's physician to confirm medications found in the client's home.
- Assessment of client's medication management needs.
- Implementation of client's individualized plan of care with participation of client and family member(s) (if applicable).
- Medication education session.

• **Periodic RN Home Visit:**

- Review medication compliance.
- Complete Nursing reassessment.
- Interface with client's physician if necessary.
- Pour medications into pillbox, or service medication dispensing device for the period if indicated.
- Medication education session. Interface with, instruct and supervise HHA if one is assigned.

• **Daily Home Health Aide Home Visit (if applicable):**

- Remind client to take medications. Assist with personal care if indicated.

• **Review and recertification of the client's plan of care is completed every 60 days.**

• **Reassessment of the client's condition and need for service is completed every 6 months.**

Cost: Nursing visits are billed at \$75 per visit. Frequency of visits will vary depending on need.
